APRIL 2019 Fuel Prices

The Minister of Finance, Sili Epa Tuioti has advised that the following changes in retail petroleum products prices will apply from 1st APRIL 2019.

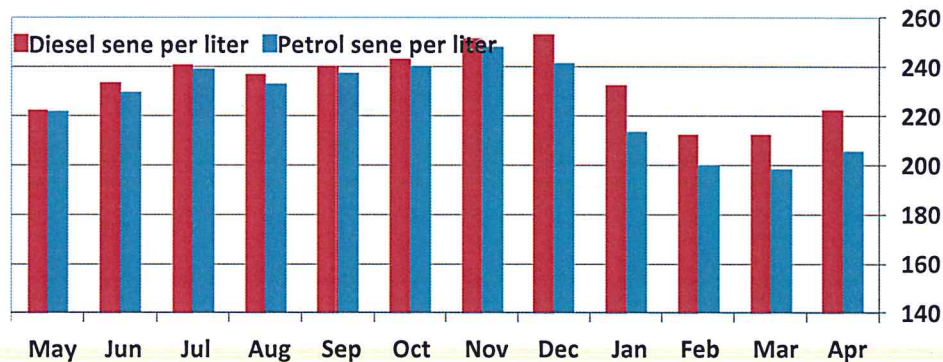
The Minister announced the increase in the Retail Price for Petrol by 8.30 sene from \$2.40 to \$2.48 per litre, Diesel by 11.6 sene from \$2.56 to \$2.67 sene per litre and for Kerosene by 9.97 sene from \$2.22 to \$2.32 sene per litre.

Crude Oil and Products prices are higher following reports the Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries' OPEC's campaign to cut production was gaining traction, but a conflicting US federal report suggested gains could be short-lived with the U.S. oil sector poised to flood the market with new supply. The Wall Street Journal reported that falling production in Venezuela, accelerated now by new U.S. sanctions, also contributed to the decline. The production cuts began last month as OPEC and allies like Russia, a major oil producer, teamed up in a bid to boost prices.
